PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The Atlantic City Convention Center was one of four locations to become pop-up hospitals to house overflow critical care patients. 250 beds were initially set up in the convention center and the facility has the capability to add more if needed.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Concord provided engineering design and field guidance for connecting four temporary stand-by generators to provide emergency power for the hospital's patient beds, HVAC, temporary showers and wash stations and all support areas.

The entire design and construction of the 80,000 sf facility was achieved in two weeks from the first meeting to the first patient accepted into the facility. The temporary field hospital opened on April 21, 2020.
