ABOUT THE CLIENT

Resorts Casino and Hotel was the first casino hotel in Atlantic City, becoming the first legal casino outside of Nevada in the United States, when it opened on May 26, 1978. The resort completed an expansion in 2004, adding the 27-story Rendezvous Tower, and underwent renovations in 2011, converting the resort to a Roaring Twenties theme.



PROJECT SUMMARY

Resorts Casino and Hotel is the original gambling casino in Atlantic City opening in May 1978. The gambling floor is 100,000 square feet and offers 2,500 slots with over 150 table games and simulcasting of live horse racing.

Concord Engineering has provided MEP/FP design of multiple large scale and smaller projects at the facility, starting with a notable \$50 million revamping in 1998 and a new \$100 million, 459-room hotel tower in 2004. Other projects included new gaming spaces, a buffet, multiple restaurants, bars and nightclubs, spa, hair salon, fitness center, 1,500 space parking garage, gift shops and over 850 hotel rooms.
